### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

**Eligibility:** This tournament is open only to archers who are existing members of ArcheryGB or another World Archery member association.

Proof of membership will be requested at the tournament.

**Club:** Because this event is organised by a county association, you must enter the tournament either as a member of your first-claim club (GNAS Law 20.b.v ) or as a Direct Member of KAA/other county/ArcheryGB (provided, of course, that you are).

**Awards:** The title of Kent County Champion will be awarded to the top placed competitor in each category. Medals will be awarded dependent on the number of competitors in each category.

1<sup>st</sup> place medals will be awarded for categories with two or more competitors. 2<sup>nd</sup> place medals will be awarded for categories with three or more competitors. 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals will be awarded for categories with four or more competitors.

Visitors awards will be made as above.

To qualify for awards, all classes must shoot as follows:

Barebow, Traditional, American Flatbow and Longbow – Blue pegs		
Recurve –	Red pegs	
Compounds –	Red Pegs	
Compound Barebow –	Blue Pegs	

Juniors and novices may elect to shoot longer or shorter distances at their own discretion. Awards will only be presented to those shooting the correct or a higher peg for their age and bowstyle

**Dress Code:** It is recommended that competitors wear bright visible colours and suitable footwear for muddy and uneven terrain.

**Lost Arrows:** In accordance with World Archery rules, searches for lost arrows must not delay shooting groups. Searches for lost arrows may continue on completion of shooting where the work party may assist. Please report all lost arrows to the tournament organiser at the end day, upon completion of scoring.

**Disclaimer:** Neither the Kent Archery Association nor the owners of the grounds can accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment while on, entering or leaving the venue. No responsibility will be accepted for damage to arrows missing or passing through a target boss.

**Refreshments:** Tea and Coffee will be available at a designated rest point on the course. No other refreshments will be provided. It is suggested that competitors bring adequate refreshments in a small rucksack to carry with them around the course.

Toilets: Chemical toilets will be available.

**Parking:** Parking space will be clearly indicated; please park considerately.

**Photography:** To comply with the ArcheryGB Policy for "Safeguarding Children, Young People & Vulnerable Adults", any person wishing to pursue any form of photography for any purpose is required to report to the tournament organiser before starting and to comply with any conditions given.

**Juniors:** All competitors under the age of 18 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or other nominated responsible adult at all times.
